### Toolbox Talk No. 79 DUST AND AIR QUALITY

### WHAT?

Dust, emissions and odours can annoy neighbours and may cause health risks at very high concentrations

### WHY?

**Avoid nuisance to neighbours**: Dust can settle on neighbours' properties and give rise to local dispute. Poorly controlled emissions and odours from plant or works may give rise to valid complaints. **Avoid programme delays**: The Local Authority has the power to stop works if dust is causing a nuisance. Emission of dark smoke from plant and fires is illegal.

**Avoid health problems**: Dust may cause eye irritation or make asthma worse **Avoid impact on ecology**: Dust can damage the ecology of a watercourse and affect plant growth, including crops

### DO

- Keep surfaces swept and damp down with water at regular intervals
- ✓ Minimise drop heights into haulage vehicles and into conveyors.
- Ensure cutting and grinding operations are adequately shielded or wetted
- Sheet lorries carrying dry materials off site
- Use the wheelwash, for appropriate vehicles, if one is provided on site
- ✓ Store fine, dry materials within buildings or provide adequate protection from the wind.
- Store bulk cement and bentonite in silos
- Position silos and stockpiles away from residential areas or watercourses.
- Clean up or damp down any spillage of dry dusty materials
- Notify your Line Manager if work activities are causing poor air quality.

### **DON'T**

- DON'T burn materials on site without approval from your Project Manager. Permission is required first from the Environment Agency
- DON'T use poorly maintained plant. Black smoke may give rise to poor health and can cause a nuisance
- DON'T leave plant running if not in use
- DON'T ignore sources of poor air quality, notify your line manager
- DON'T ignore complaints

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### Toolbox Talk No. 88 BUYING TIMBER - FSC AND PEFC

### Forestry - what are the issues?

- Illegal logging
- Change of land use e.g. palm oil, farming
- Soil destabilisation
- Government corruption
- Human / civil rights
- Impact on biodiversity 4000 hardwood species – many at risk of extinction

### Why use timber?

- Renewable and sustainable
- High strength to weight ratio
- Low energy cost in production
- Versatile product

### How can we protect forests then?

- Forest Stewardship Council promotes responsible management of the world's forests
- Covers 174 million hectares of forest
- Certification and product labelling of woodbased products (paper and wood) from wellmanaged forests
- Programme for the Endorsement of Forest
   Certification promotes sustainable forest
   management
- Covers 243 million hectares of forest
- Sustainable means that they will plant more trees than are taken down





### What does FSC or PEFC certification mean?

- Unbroken chain of forest-based products from a certified forest through to the customer
- The label says 'this product has been made with timber from well-managed forests and we can prove
  it'

### What are Raphael Contracting doing and why?

- We are certified to sell products with Chain of Custody to the FSC or PEFC standards
- This is so that we can prove to our main customers that the timber and joinery we have purchased is from a managed source and we can give them the documentation to prove it.
- The main contractors are insisting that we become FSC / PEFC certified so that we can give them the assurance that the timber we buy is from a managed source
- We can sell timber and timber products (carpentry, joinery and decking) with FSC and PEFC claims
- We care about the environment. We already have ISO14001 and have made a commitment to sustainable business. We don't want to knowingly buy timber from illegal sources. Timber is our main material and product, so we need to protect it.

### What does this mean in practice?

 We have a policy and procedures that outline how we will control our purchases and deliveries (and paperwork) so that we can prove we have purchased FSC / PEFC timber.
